- Göbeklitepe, Şanlıurfa is worth seeing because it is too important place for the history of the world. There is oldest known-place and first worship center in the world.

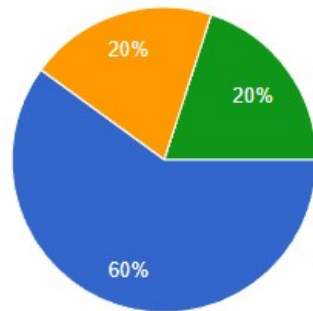

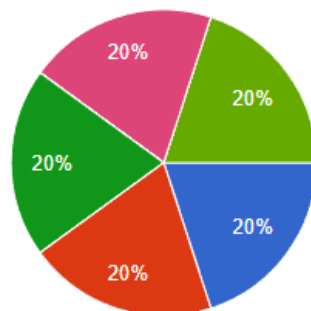
